Organist, professor in the Instrumental Department of the Academy of Music in Gdańsk.

A graduate of both the Academy, where she studied with prof. Roman Perucki, and of Hochschule für Musik und Theater in Hamburg (honours degree), where she studied with Wolfgang Zerer. Hanna Dys received several scholarships, including Brahms Stiftung, Scholarship for Culture Creators and Scholarship of the Minister of Science and Higher Education. A participant and winner of international competitions.

She leads an active concert life, performs at international organ music festivals in Poland and Europe (Germany, Finland, Norway, Moldavia, Spain, Russia, Italy, Norway and other countries). Her concert performances promote Polish organ music and she chose to record a monographic album with works by Mieczysław Surzyński for her habilitation. She contributed to recording the complete organ symphonies by Feliks Nowowiejski. She is a music promoter, e.g. as the artistic director of the Organ and Chamber Music Festival in Grudziądz. She teaches organ at the General School of Music in Gdańsk. Her pupils and students are prizewinners in organ competitions. She regularly provides masterclass in Poland and abroad, in Russia, Lithuania, Italy. Hanna Dys is a member of jury in organ competitions and a consultant to the Centre for Artistic Education. Her recordings include both solo and chamber music repertoire.
